## Rider Education Notes From our Chapter Director

### **LINDA's LESSON**

Winter arrived December 21st. This is a good sign that serious riding season is behind us for another year and most of us are ready to put the motorcycles away for the winter. Using the word **“WINTER”** I have listed a few things to think about when storing your bike.

**W** - Winterize your bike. This could include many things. Some people like to ride occasionally during the winter to keep the bike maintained. Some people will add Stabil to their gas tank to protect the gas in the tank.

**I** - Install new chrome. If you have been good this year maybe Santa has brought you new **chrome that you can install on your bike. If Santa didn't bring the chrome maybe you will have to purchase some.**

**N** - Nuts, bolts, and screws. While winterizing your bike, this is a good time to check for loose nuts, bolts, screws, etc. Tighten them up or maybe even replace them.

**T** - Tires are another important part of the bike to check. This is a good time to check the wear and tear on the tires. It might be necessary to change tires before the next riding season.

**E** - Examine your bike. As you are winterizing your bike there are many other items to check besides the ones already mentioned. You may need to change the fluids in the bike. Check any wear and tear on the bike such as lights, wiring, helmet cords, etc.

**R** - Remove your battery or put a battery tender on it. This becomes a personal preference. It also depends on weather and how much you are able to ride the bike.

Hopefully this will remind you of some tasks to do to winterize your bike. Hope you have a great holiday season and polar bear ride. Look forward to riding next spring.
